Helpful Hints About Living at Schwenckfeld Manor or Schwenckfeld Terrace

"What if I have a medical emergency?"

Each apartment is outfitted with at least two emergency pull cords. If you pull the cord, it will alert the office that you need emergency assistance. Please be advised that this does not guarantee that a staff member will always be able to respond. This system is to be used for emergencies only. Also, Advanced Living Communities offers its own in-house PresAlert system. PresAlert is a pendant or bracelet that you can wear and press if you have a medical emergency. There is a one-time charge for PresAlert, and more details are available through the main office. Lastly, residents are permitted to contract with an outside vendor for an emergency call service at their own expense.

If you live at Schwenckfeld Manor, (East, West, or South buildings) when you pull your pull cord, you will hear a loud bell ringing, a light over your door will turn on, and your door will unlock automatically. Note: If you are responding to this alarm, the apartment door will seem to be locked; do not try to turn the door knob, just push to open your neighbor's door.

If you live at Schwenckfeld Terrace, a light over your door will turn on, but there are no loud bells in the hallway and your door will not unlock.

In either case, you or your neighbor should call 9-1-1- if you have an emergency after hours.
